Participants Age of participants Weight categories	International Judo Tournament among police and army forces in memory of officers killed on duty. Maximal amount of participants: 5 athletes, 5 substitutes (1 substitute is authorised per each weight category), 1 coach, 1 official. The competitions are held between men teams. The participants must be 30+. Competitions are held in the following weight categories: - 66kg, -73kg, - 81kg, -90kg, +90kg. At the weigh-in and accreditation the competitors are to show the official document: passport, service certificate or military ID. Those athletes are not allowed to participate who are in the official lists of the selected judo and sambo teams of Russia 2011-2012.	
Competition System	Competitions are held on Olympic system with repechage from quarter-finalists, 2 third places.	
Judogis	According to the IJF rules the athletes are to have both white and blue judogis. Athletes must have official EJU backnumbers that could be obtained via www.mybacknumber.com . Without an official backnumber the athlete is not allowed to participate in the competitions. EJU backnumber of the previous year (2011) is still acceptable for this year competitions. If the judogis do not meet the demands of both EJU and IJF including the name and country patch, the athlete will be disqualified.	
Referee	Referees are appointed by EJU	
Referee meeting	Referee meeting will take place on Friday, April 6th 2012 at 19:00 at the hotel “Salut”.	
Draw	The draw will take place on the day before the competition at 20:00 at the hotel « Salut ».	

Accreditation	The accreditation of the delegations takes place at the hotel "Salut" on April 5 th :15.00 - 20.00, April 6 th :10.00 - 18.00
