



Invitation to enter

15th European Police Championships Track and Field

The Central Sport Militia Club of Ukraine was entrusted with the organisation of the 15th European Police Championships Track and Field by the Union Sportive des Polices d'Europe.

The following invitation to enter is issued for the 2010 EPC Track and Field.

1. General Organiser

2. Organiser

3. Date

Arrival: 22.09.2010

Competition: 23.09.10 and 24.09.10

Departure: 25.09.2010

4. Venue

Donetsk

5. Accommodation

Hotel accommodation for all participants will be provided.

6. Competition rules

The rules laid down by the I.A.A.F. and of the USPE Competition Rules (number 4.7) shall apply. The following competitions for men and women are offered.

Each member union is allowed to enter up to 28 male and female competitors as well as 4 attendants.

However, the number of attendants must not exceed the number of sportsmen/-women. Each member union may enter up to two contestants per individual discipline with regard to both men's and ladies' events. One team per relay event may be entered.

Any protest must be filed in writing in one of the three official languages of the USPE within one hour after the respective competition is over. The protest fee will total 100 Euros.

8. Eligibility to enter

The provisions laid down in the Statutes, the Rules and Regulations, the Competition Rules as well as the Anti-Doping Regulations of the USPE shall apply.

Doping tests will be conducted during the Championship, with the current WADA list of prohibited substances being applicable. (www.wada-ama.org).

Article 23 Statutes: The Competitors

- (1) Participation in Championships is restricted to athletes who:
1. meet the starting requirements of their International Union,
 2. belong to a National sport's organisation that is a member of USPE,
 3. are police officers or
 4. are police students at a public Police Academy,
 5. have reached the age of 18 years at the of the Championship
 6. and have signed the Anti-Doping Declaration.

Article R 12/2 of the Rules and Regulations: Competitors

- (1) In order to be able to take part in an European championship organised by the USPE, the members of the member unions have to fulfil the following conditions:
1. They have to satisfy the provisions set out in Article 23 of the Statutes.
 2. They have to be police officers or students at a public police academy. The police are a set of all bodies and institutions in charge of maintenance of public law and order (administrative police and crime investigation departments).
- (2) Military police, members of the military, members of the fire brigades and civil servants that do not belong to the police are excluded from European police championships.

Sub-paragraph 1.5 of the Competition Rules

Sportsmen and sportswomen having participated in military championships are not eligible to enter European police championship for 12 months following these military championships.

Sub-paragraph 1.6 of the Competition Rules

Competitors suspended from sports contests by the respective sports association due to having violated the relevant doping regulations are not eligible to enter.

Sub-paragraph 1.7 of the Competition Rules

All teams shall wear uniform sportswear displaying the emblems of their individual member union.

9. Verification of eligibility to enter

For verifying a competitor's eligibility to start, the production of his/her police ID as well as his/her passport/personal identity card and the signed Anti-Doping Declaration will be required. This verification will be effected by the representative of the Technical Commission, Mr. Brian Brunton.

10. Expenses/fees

Travelling expenses

Each member union will defray their own travelling expenses.

Board and lodging

Delegate

The expenses incurred by the delegate (Article R 11 of the Rules and Regulations) of the respective member union will be paid by the organiser.

Team

For all participants 30, -- EUR per person per night are to be paid to the organizer (Article R 14/3 of the Rules and Regulations).

Should a member union intend to take guests along with them to an EPC and should the organiser be able to provide the respective accommodation, each guest shall pay the actual costs incurred by them.

11. Registration fee

Article R 14/2 of the Rules and Regulations:

(1) Prior to a championship each participating nation is to pay a registration fee to the General Treasurer of the USPE.

(2) These fees have to be paid before the opening of the championship.

(3) A member union not complying with this commitment is excluded from participation.

Registration fees:

Per individual start: 20,- EUR

Per relay team : 60,- EUR

The respective invoices will be sent to the participating member countries in time. Participation will be refused to a member organisation having failed to pay registration fees.
