



complies with the following conditions of participation in a USPE European Police Championship (EPC); he/she

1. satisfies the relevant entry conditions established by the International Federation,
 2. belongs to a national organization that is a member of the USPE,
 3. is a member of the police profession and works actively in law enforcement to ensure the security of property and persons or the maintenance of public order, or, failing that, is a trainee at a police school and in line to become a member of the police profession,
 4. will be at least 18 years old by the first day of the European Police Championship in question,
 5. must sign the USPE anti-doping declaration,
 6. will be able to present to the USPE technical delegate a police ID as well as a further identification document, both of which are valid,
 7. is not a member of a military police unit, a military unit, or a firefighting unit,
 8. is not a member of a civilian profession,
 9. is not under disciplinary sanctions for violation of anti-doping rules;
- ⇒ the competitor is aware that these conditions apply to the final phase just as much as they do to the preliminary phase of the USPE European Police Championship;
- ⇒ I undertake to deliver this declaration of participation or to have it delivered to the USPE Technical Delegate or USPE Official Observer during accreditation at the European Police Championship or Preliminary Round of an EPC.
